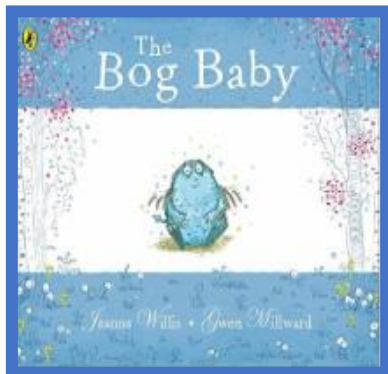
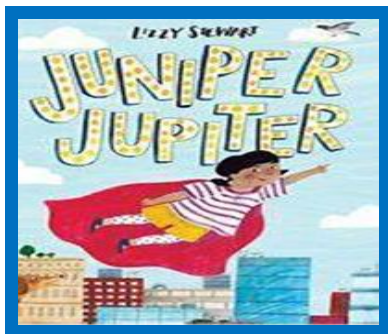

What are we going to be learning?

This term we have a great selection of books we will be exploring. Kicking straight off with Superheroes; this week we have read *Superhero Hotel* and next week we will continue the theme and read *Juniper Jupiter*.

Moving on from this we will read *Clean Up* and explore the sea. We will discover how we can all be real life superheroes by helping to protect the oceans and the creatures that live in them.

As the weather starts to warm up and we transition into Spring we will be reading the book *Bog Baby* and *Busy in Spring*. The children will get an opportunity to make their very own Bog Baby and go on a Spring Walk, looking for signs of Spring.
