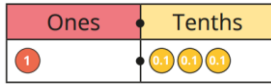


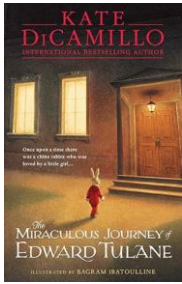
Year 4 Newsletter

Maths and English

In Maths, we will begin by focusing on decimals, building a secure understanding of tenths and hundredths. We will then move on to our measurement unit, where children will apply their knowledge of decimals and fractions to solve problems involving money. Throughout the term, we will also continue to practise and develop our times tables fluency in preparation for the upcoming Multiplication Tables Check in June.

In English, this term promises a range of exciting writing opportunities. We will begin by exploring extracts from 'The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane', using the text as inspiration to write our own narratives. Children will develop their descriptive writing, focusing on character, setting and emotion.

Foundation Subjects

In Science, we'll journey into the workings of the digestive system, unlocking the secrets of how our bodies process food. We will conclude our studies on the Vikings, Scots and Saxons in History. In Religious Education, we will learn about the importance of Hajj in Islam. Finally, in Art, we will be exploring Frida Kahlo's artistry, focusing on sketching and collage techniques inspired by her vibrant style.



Multiplication Check

Year 4 will sit their statutory multiplication tables check in June. It is important that all children are practising their times tables regularly at home. They can practise with family members or friends, record this in their home learning journals, and should access T.T.R.S. for at least 5 minutes each day.

Home Learning

There are few things as powerful as reading regularly with your child! Daily reading is such an important part of your child's routine, and we would encourage this to be recorded in the home learning journal.
