Learning

In Science, we will be continuing our focus on plants. We will be looking at the different types of plants and have planned a trip to Greenwich Park linked to Science Week. In Geography, we will be learning about different types of weather and when they occur. In R.E., we will be continuing our learning about Judaism, exploring Jewish festivals and stories.



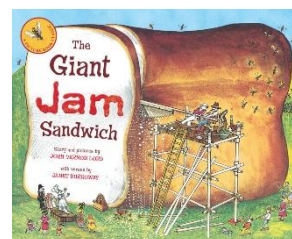
Maths

In Maths, we will be learning to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will then move on to multiplication and division. This will include making and sharing equal groups, as well as finding doubles. We will also be learning about fractions, including halves, quarters and wholes, and finding half and a quarter of different quantities.

In addition, we will be learning to tell the time to the hour, half past, quarter past and quarter to. We will also be exploring money, learning the value of different coins and notes, and practising adding and subtracting different amounts.

English

We will be focussing on ensuring we can write an accurate sentence. We will be doing this by exploring wonderful texts such as; Little Red Riding Hood text and The giant jam sandwich!



Home Learning

We ask that the children continue to bring their reading journals in every day and we recommend 10 minutes minimum every night. Numbots is another great resource children can use to support their maths learning at home. Log ins are in the back on the reading journals. A reminder to also bring a P.E. kit in on a Monday and we will send it home on Friday. P.E. kit should be blue or white t-shirt, blue, black shorts or tracksuit and trainers.
